Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the 5th Cycle (February 20, 2017 – April 13, 2017).

Objectives

- District-wide totals are based on the number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from PEIMS (February 20 – April 13).

Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

Results

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD for the 5th cycle is 95.87%.
- The lowest total attendance averages are for 12th graders at 93.53% followed by 11th graders at 94.60% (Not including EE 94.02%).
- The highest attendance averages are in the 5th grade at 96.78% followed by 3rd graders at 96.68%.
