Subject: Consider Approval of a Resolution for Votes on the Young County Appraisal District Board of Directors Election

Background Information: During the regular Board meeting on October 8, 2025, The GISD Board of Trustees made nominations for representatives on the Young County Appraisal District Board of directors. Each county taxing entity now should decide how to designate its votes to the nominated candidates. Graham ISD will determine distribution of its own 1558 votes as well as the 98 NCTC votes. Votes designated to each taxing entity are based on the entity's total tax levy from 2024 as a percent of the total county tax levy.

Administrative Consideration: GISD Board will determine the distribution of votes for YCAD Board of Director candidates through a Board Resolution.
