## RESILIENT SCHOOL SUPPORT PROGRAM OR RSSP

Participation in RSSP provides the following support for districts that apply and are selected to participate:

- COVID instructional recovery and acceleration needs are evaluated by the technical assistance team selected by the Texas Education Agency the team provided direct support based on identified needs.
- Ed Direction was the team selected to work with United ISD and they support in crafting a recovery and acceleration implementation plan specific to UISDs needs.
- Campus level support through professional development and non-evaluative teacher observations
- The RSSP team at TEA is a direct line for support and resources based on periodic district check-ins

## UISD AND RSSP GOALS

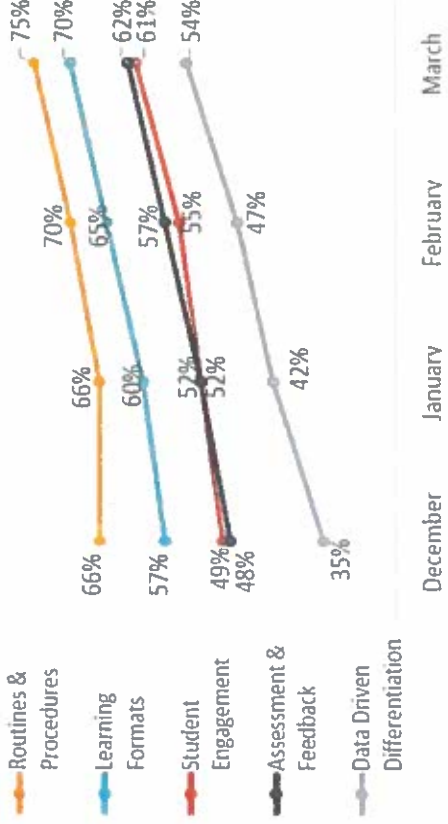
Year 1 Goals – Work began in late November, 2020

1. To increase teacher clarity on what good virtual/hybrid instruction looks like with 75% of teachers in agreement or an increase of 10% of teachers from the baseline data.
2. Increase satisfaction with professional development resources and training with 75% of teachers agreeing that virtual PD resources were useful.
3. Integrate effective instructional strategies to maximize student assignment completion with a 10% increase of assignment completion.
4. Integrate effective instructional strategies to maximize student engagement with a 10% increase in student engagement.
5. Increase the implementation of Best Practices in Virtual Instruction on a district-wide basis with an increase of 10% in the implementation of best practices.

# DATA ON MEETING YEAR 1 GOALS

Increase the implementation of Best Practices in Virtual Instruction on a district-wide basis with an increase of 10% in the implementation of best practices. Over 200 PD modules have been completed by teachers since January 28th! ✓

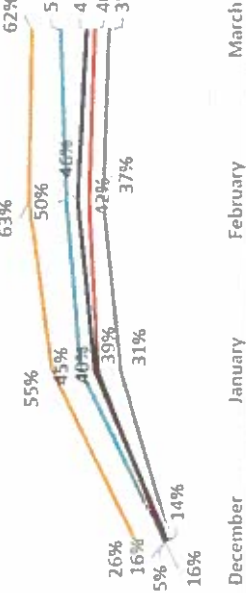
**United: 23% increase in the "Proficient" category (n=1,312)**

## RSSP YEAR 2 GOALS

Year 2 Goals – Planning has already begun and will progress through the summer months to be ready for the 2021-22 school year:

1. Continue with implementation of on-demand professional development modules to improve instruction.
2. Continue with implementation of PLC scope and sequence with selected feeder to provide support in meeting standards.
3. Create professional development modules on social and emotional wellness for teachers as a Segway to the SEL program for students for the 2021-22 school year.
4. Create professional development modules to capitalize on technology used this year and align instruction to online assessments and expand the use of United ISDs Learning Space to house all PD modules.
5. Create online resources for parents to support summer learning.
