Tomahawk High School:

The One-Act Play concluded their season on Friday November 22 at the State Theatre Competition in Milwaukee. The drama program represented the district to the highest of standards and took home many awards and honors for their performance of Ten Actors in Search of a Cell Phone. The group received the Critic's Choice Award for their efforts which equates to essentially the State Championship at the State Theatre Level. The group also took home the Outstanding Ensemble and Outstanding Technical awards. In addition, Directors, Michele Balda and Corey Colburn received Outstanding Director Awards. Lastly, Alena Cerkas, Landon Plantenberg, Sadie Ruder, and Maddie Long were recognized individually with Outstanding Actor Awards. Congratulations to the cast and crew on these outstanding honors, and their hard work and dedication throughout the season to put on such a wonderful show for the public and student body at the Tomahawk School District.
