Principal Update

The search for a new principal for Laura B. Sprague continues. We advertised the position as both a full-time and an interim opportunity. Interviews will begin the week of June 23 with the goal to bring a final candidate to the Board at the July Regular meeting.

Sprague Traffic and Parking

The approved 2016 special use permit ordinance for Sprague School, which includes the “findings of fact” prepared by Wight architects (starting on page 12) is available for the Board to review. According to the Village’s zoning code, the primary parking requirement for schools is to provide one parking space per employee or faculty member; there is no specific requirement for visitor parking on site.

The zoning code also allows parking facilities used solely for employees to be located on a separate lot, provided that no such parking spaces are located more than 600 feet from the nearest building entrance, measured along a paved pedestrian circulation route. The swim club parking lot is very close to the 600 limit for off site parking, making it a viable option for staff parking. An estimate to repair the parking lot if the swim club would contract the work is estimated at \$50,000 for an overlay mill and pave at 2” and \$75,000 for a remove and replace at 4”. We are continuing to review the parking at Sprague and its impact on traffic.

The next step in the process regarding the traffic issues is to survey the community about why they drive their children everyday to and from school. We will send the survey in early August when parents will be expecting school notifications. The results of the survey will be available at the August Board meeting.

FOIA requests

The District received two FOIA requests this month.

1. Laura Veas requested contractual rates for each vendor the district has contracted for social work, psychologist, and behavior analyst (BCBA) services for the 2023-2024 school year, 2024 ESY and 2024-2025 school year.
2. CT Mills from Public Info Access requested a list of all school and district-level administrators, including: name, title/position, work email address and work location (School Name or Central Office).
