Subject: Consider Approval of an Agreement With BP America to Fund the Construction of a Compressed Natural Gas Fueling Station and Related Equipment/Facilities at the Central Support Facility				
Background: Grant funding, from BP America, provides for the construction of a compressed natural gas fueling station, the conversion of 44 district buses to CNG, the construction of a CNG vehicle maintenance bay and the construction of additional parking at the Central Support Facility. The agreement includes a requirement to use Gas Equipment Systems, Inc. for the CNG station, Emission Solutions, Inc. for the bus conversions and Centerpoint Energy for the gas line improvements. All reasonable and necessary costs associated with the project will be reimbursed 100 percent by BP America.
