Re: Instructional Materials and Technology Allotment (IMAT) Funds Request

Currently, we are requesting the Instructional Materials and Technology Allotment of approval of funds not to exceed the amount of \$1,200,000.00 to support in curriculum and instruction resources for campuses for the 2026-2027 school year.

As a reminder, the Instructional Materials Allotment (IMAT) is provided by the state to help support districts in purchasing aligned instructional supports to be implemented into the curriculum and instruction structures for learning. Each year we work together as a curriculum team and gather feedback from campus leadership/educators to review past purchases, current needs, future needs based on our data, alignment of TEKS (Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills) as well as specific new resources per the state. Each year the list may vary based on licenses, needs in various content areas as well as reviewing usage data/needs for resources. We are also continuing to review guidance and legal requirements from the state as a part of our practice in reviewing instructional materials and using these funds as well as other utilizing allotments through the high-quality instructional materials (HQIM) and State Board of Education Approved Instructional Material Entitlement and State-Developed Open Education (OER) Entitlement funding.

We are requesting expenditures from the IMAT allotment for the 2026-2027 for the following:
