## **Pacific High School**

- Fully staffed- no open positions
- ASB worked to welcome 7th grade back for the year
- Friday Electives are in full swing
- Staff PD will focus on improving writing proficiency
  - Identifying power standards
  - Staff will collaborate/develop a plan to integrate writing and address power standards across the curriculum
  - Working with the Oregon Writing Project for October 11th inservice.
    - They are interested in sending someone out
- Updated cell phone policy
  - Cannot be out of lockers throughout the school day
  - Working with Yonder to order locking bags and coordinate community outreach prior to implementation
  - Not too much pushback at this point- students have been great
- Fall Sports are off and running

## **Driftwood Elementary**

- Construction/Renovation is nearing completion
- Staffing needs
  - o 1 aide position open
  - o Posting for 2nd Kindergarten Teacher
- Kindergarten adjustments
  - Enrollment requires breaking class into two groups
  - o "Waterfall" schedule will continue until 9/23

- If no 2nd Kindergarten teacher by then, move to half-day kindergarten schedule (AM/PM classes)
- o Half-day will continue until a second teacher is hired
- If no teacher hired before 900 instruction hours threshold, half-day kindergarten will continue throughout the year
- o Assessing possible spaces to accommodate 2nd full-day class if teacher is hired
- Upcoming Title I night
  - o survey for parent input going out shortly
  - o Title I room is up and running
- Staff is picking up where they left off last year with identified power standards for math and ELA.
- Fall Festival/Pumpkin Patch on October 4th, 4:30-7 PM
