

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is an essential component to a student's academic success. We understand that absences occur due to illness, appointments, family emergencies and special circumstances and we do not want sick children to come to school. However, all absences impact student performance and they miss out on valuable instruction time. Please attempt to make appointments, vacations or family days out of school instruction time when possible.

Garibaldi Grade School will closely monitor and follow Oregon State laws on attendance and truancy. Attendance Requirements in Oregon are as follows:

Students are considered having irregular attendance when the student meets any of the following (ORS 339.065):

- Eight (8) unexcused one half days absences in any four-week period.
- Five (5) absences (excused OR unexcused) in three (3) months.
- Ten (10) absences (excused OR unexcused) in six (6) months.

Parents are required to notify school to get an absence excused. You can call the GGS office at: 503-322-0311, send a note/Drs. Note or email us at delorae@nknsd.org. When your child's absences exceed these amounts (unexcused and/or excused), the school district will notify you of your child's irregular attendance. The school may also contact our truancy officer to assist families and students with chronic irregular attendance.
