

Preparation and Planning (January 2024)

Establish a Committee or Task Force: Form a diverse group including administrators, teachers, students, parents, and community members to ensure a broad perspective.

Gather Information: Conduct surveys, interviews, and focus groups to understand school and community partners' perspectives, aspirations, and values related to education.

Analysis and Reflection (January 2024)

Review Existing Statements: Evaluate the current vision and mission statements, if any, to understand what has been successful and what needs improvement.

Identify Strengths and Challenges: Assess the school's strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats (SWOT analysis) to identify areas for improvement and growth.

Vision Development (February 2024)

Draft the Vision Statement: Based on the insights gathered, craft a concise and inspiring statement that outlines the school's aspirations and long-term goals.



Mission Crafting (February-March 2024)

Define the Purpose: Define the school's fundamental purpose, including its core values, educational philosophy, and the unique contributions it aims to make.

Write the Mission Statement: Create a succinct, action-oriented statement that describes the school's primary objectives, target audience, and methods for achieving the vision.

Refinement and Validation (April-May 2024)

Feedback and Iteration: Share the draft vision and mission statements with school and community partners for feedback. Revise based on the input received to ensure inclusivity and alignment.

Finalize the Statements: Consolidate the feedback and make final adjustments to the vision and mission statements, ensuring they reflect the collective values and aspirations of the school community.

Implementation and Communication (June-August 2024)

Adoption and Integration: Integrate the new vision and mission statements into the school's culture, curriculum, policies, and practices.

Communication and Engagement: Communicate the new statements widely to students, staff, parents, and the broader community through various channels, emphasizing the school's commitment to the shared vision and mission.
