Re: Social and Emotional Learning Curriculum

The district determined there was a need for a Social and Emotional Learning Curriculum tool to help district personnel implement the Positive Character Trait and Health TEKS as well as an effective, research-based Tier 1 intervention for all learners. As a result, the district issued a Request for Proposal on 05/09/2022, to select a company to provide a comprehensive SEL SUPPORT to include ready to use lessons for staff in English and Spanish, data and reporting in order to drive continuous school improvement and ensure informed, whole-child instruction. The district received four compliant responses.

An evaluation committee comprised of representatives from all levels (Elementary, Middle and High) and central administration departments evaluated those responses to establish the best value. The resulting tabulation of those evaluations provided the following suppliers.

- 1. Character Strong (High School)
- 2. Committee for Children (Second Step) (Elementary and Middle School)

The district administration intends to use ESSER funds to cover the cost of this service for at least the first year of the award.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approve CISD administration to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the recommended suppliers, renewed annually, not to exceed approximately \$120,000.00 annually, as long as the service continues to meet the needs of the district.
