Background Information: To continue with the school bus replacement plan we have added to buses to the Navarro ISD fleet with improved safety features as we conditioning. There are currently seven buses that remain in our factors.					d safety features as well as air		

model year 2008. Five are general education buses that are not equipped with air conditioning and two that are equipped to service students with special needs and include air conditioning.

Reviewing usage, we operated three of the general education model year 2008 buses last school year, 2024-2025, for one class trip to Schlitterbahn. The two equipped for special needs served as spare buses for special education operations and were utilized regularly.

Upon this review I am recommending that we auction two of the general education model year 2008 buses which were replaced by the 2025/2026 International School buses delivered July 22, 2025.
