**ITEM:** VI.H.

**TOPIC:**               **Approval of Contract with Microsoft Enterprise**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District accept the bid recommendation from Microsoft Enterprise for Microsoft Operating System and enter into a three-year contract. Also move that the Board authorize the superintendent or his designee to sign said contract on behalf of the Livonia Public Schools' Board of Education. The annual subscription cost is \$81,495.27, for a total of \$244,485.81 for three years.

**RATIONALE:**

The District is currently using six different versions of the operating system and six different versions of Microsoft Office. This agreement would keep the Microsoft software current on all Windows computers and servers, added devices would automatically be licensed and any Microsoft upgrades would be at no charge to the district.

**BUDGETARY INFORMATION:**

The funding source for this purchase is the District's Building and Site Technology Replacement Fund.
