<u>Information</u>: Senate Bill 1357 directs the district's School Health Advisory Committee (SHAC) to recommend to the Board of Trustees a comprehensive coordinated health education program that has been TEA approved and is designed to prevent obesity, cardiovascular disease, and Type 2 Diabetes in children. The Beeville ISD SHAC met on February 8, 2006 and reviewed four TEA approved programs: *CATCH*, *Healthy and Wise*, *Bienstar Health Program*, and *The Great Body Shop*. After careful consideration, the SHAC agreed to recommend *The Great Body Shop* to the Board of Trustees for approval. The district adopted <u>The Great Body Shop</u> health textbook last year for implementation so the committee felt this coordinated health program would complement the textbook and ancillary materials already being used. Teachers utilizing the textbook felt it is a good program and would like to continue its use.
