### **Personnel**

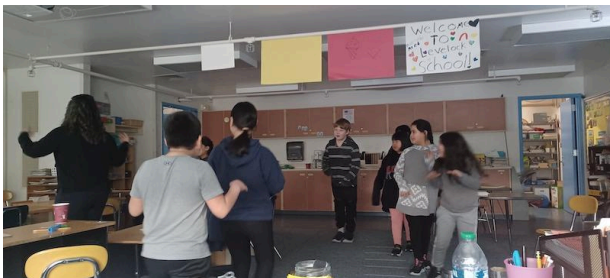
