ACADEMICS

Results Driven Accountability Report (RDA) 2023-2024 Update

Mr. Gray Browning presented the GISD Results Driven Accountability Report. This report is disseminated annually to local education agencies and provides data reflecting the performance of students participating in selected program areas (Bilingual Education/English as Second Language/Emergent Bilingual, Other Special Populations inclusive of students in Foster Care, students who are Homeless, students who are Military Connected, and Special Education). This system is used by the TEA as part of its annual evaluation of LEA performance and program effectiveness.

Effective Schools Framework (ESF) Targeted Improvement Plan (TIP) Update

Mr. Gary Browning presented a summary of the activities outlined in the TIP intended to increase student achievement. The goal of the ESF is to provide a clear vision for what districts and schools across the state do to ensure an excellent education for all Texas Students. Graham ISD has continued to participate in school improvement efforts at Graham Junior High School through the ESF. The component of ESF that drives school improvement is the Targeted Improvement Plan (TIP).

TECHNOLOGY: eRATE UPDATE

Technology Director, Chris Raisle shared the eRate update with the board. This is the final year for the 5-year Category 2, CAT2, eRate funding cycle. Category 2 includes internal connections including wireless, network equipment, and other infrastructure items. We have an existing \$36,000 remaining that has to be spent this year. Next year we will start a new 5-year funding cycle that should give the district a new budget with approximately \$380,000 total funds to use over the next 5 years eRate allows us an 80% discount on hardware, installation and support for these projects due to our socioeconomic status.

Our Technology Department is planning a multi-year project to upgrade the aging wireless district wide. The plan will be to utilize the \$36,000 from this year's funds and finish the project next year with the start of the new budget cycle. The project will include 62 network drops and 265 wireless access points with 5-year warranty and support.
