TOPIC: Approval of HVAC Installation at Auto and Wood Shops

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve funding for the purchase and installation of HVAC units for the auto and wood shops at Churchill High School, Franklin High School, Stevenson High School, and the Livonia Career Technical Center from Quality Air Systems, located in Whitmore, Michigan for a total cost of \$1,326,080, which includes contingency.

RATIONALE:

This project will replace the original heat only HVAC systems in these high school wood and auto shops. The new HVAC systems will include both heat and air conditioning in these classrooms. LCTC and Stevenson have an auto shop and a wood shop/construction trades room. Churchill and Franklin only have wood shops.
