As we approach the end of the year, our focus is on concluding several projects while also preparing for the upcoming year. Here is an update on our key initiatives:

Camera Replacement:

- Progress: Phase 3 of the camera replacement project is nearly complete at 95%. Most interior cameras are now installed.
- Next Steps: Installation of approximately 5 outdoor cameras remains, requiring the use of a boom for placement on the building's exterior.

Vape Detectors:

• Installation Complete: Vape detectors have been successfully installed at Napi and BES.

Network Updates:

- Current Status: We have updated the firmware on our switches and firewall. Approximately half of our caching servers are operational again.
- Goal: Complete the restoration of all caching servers by the end of the school year.

E-Rate Funding:

- Awards Received: We have secured E-Rate funding for both category 1 and 2.
- Developments: We will receive new redundant infrastructure from Siyhee, although no awards were granted for category 2 this cycle due to spending our 5 year allocation.

Account Management:

 Efforts: Heidi Crawford has diligently worked to streamline account management, achieving a cost reduction of over \$2,000 in monthly expenses.

Preparations for Next Year:

- Planning: We are in the process of planning for both student and staff devices.
- Reorganization: A new profile scheme is being developed in Mosyle, allowing tech mentors to manage teachers' apps within their respective buildings.
- Tech Mentor Meeting: We will have one more tech mentor meetings before the end of the school year.
