- Selene Ulsemer, from Mexico, provided a cultural class for 30 minutes daily

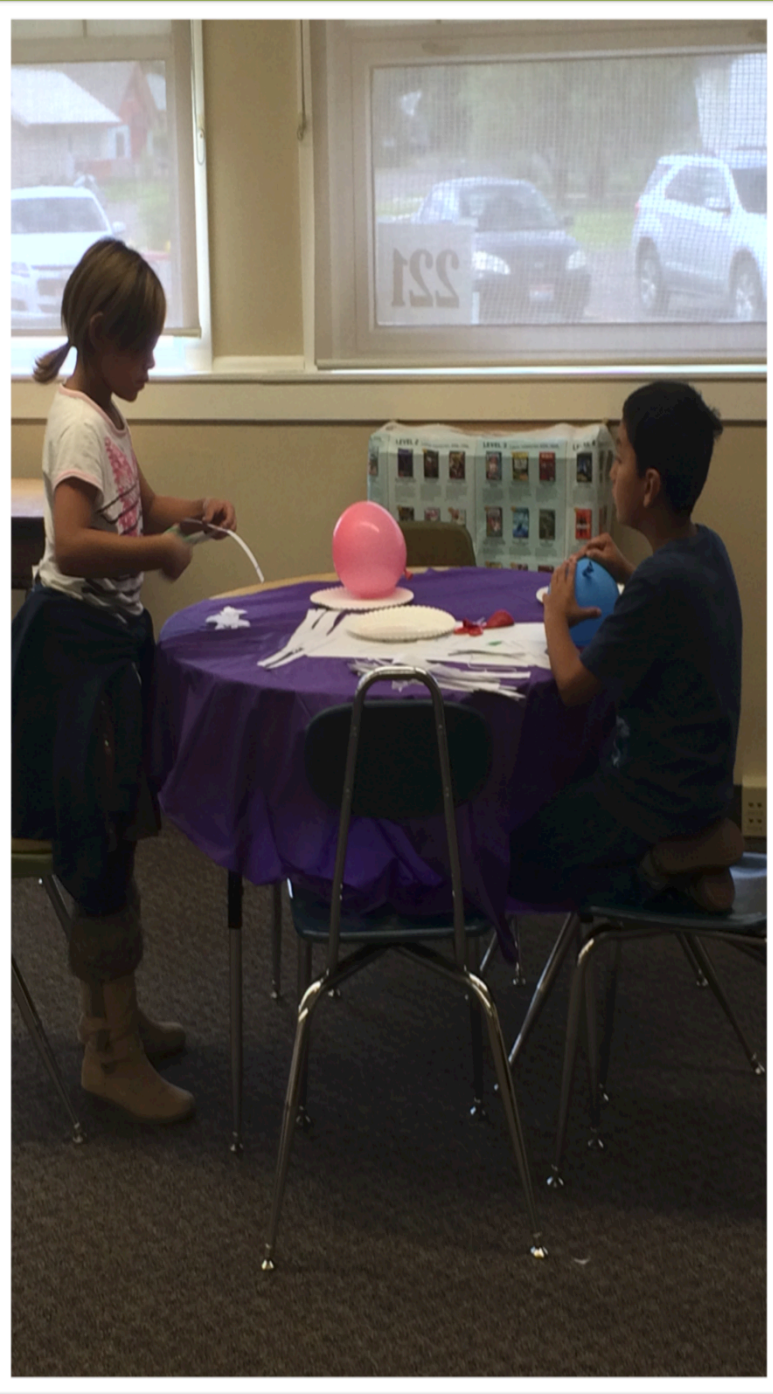
