Dear Mr. Andrews:

In 1982 your firm drilled a hot water well for this school district. Shortly after completion and putting the well into service it became evident that we did not have a good seal on the well.

After several communications, your firm did come and give the well some additional attention at that time. The problem persists however and is steadily getting worse. I now believe we are in danger of losing the well entirely.

Howard, I have told you of my concerns repeatedly over the last three years. Each time you assure me you will check it out or that you have checked it out and we should wait and see what develops.

I have trusted you and your firm to do right by the School District. I do not have a great deal of expertise in this area and so must depend on your expertise and integrity.

The well is so bad as to be dangerous at this point. Even a novice can see something must be done soon.

I have checked with several entities and each of them indicated that your firm has both the legal and the moral obligation to properly install, cap and seal the well.

It has washed away the earth from around the well. I cannot tell how deep the hole might be but if a child happens to be injured or worse, neither you nor I will ever be excused. Additionally, if we are not able to heat the school this



winter because proper attention has not been paid to this well, the cost will be great . The District does not plan to bear that cost nor the possible disruption to the school system.

Please give this matter your immediate attention.
