

CALENDAR FOR TRUSTEE ELECTION
Saturday MAY 14, 2011

Three Trustee places are up for election. Two 3-year terms, Brad Coe and Dan Laws, and one 1-year term, previously held by Mark Frerich, and currently filled by appointee Rick Alvarado.. Candidate packets are available at the Brackett ISD Central Administration Office beginning Monday, February 7, 2011.

- 2/12/11** **First day to file an application for a place on the ballot.**
- 3/14/11** **Last day to file application for a place on the ballot: 5:00 p.m. deadline.**
Last day to order general election to be held May 14, 2011.
- 3/15/11 First day to accept applications for early voting ballots by mail.
- 3/22/11 Recommended date to conduct ballot position drawing.
5:00 p.m. – Deadline for a candidate to withdraw in an election.
First day an election may be cancelled if all filing deadlines have passed and each candidate for an office listed on the ballot is unopposed.
- 3/31/10 First day early voting clerk may begin mailing early voting ballots to applicants.
- 4/14/11 Last day to register to vote.
- 4/25/11 Last day to post Notice of Election.
- 4/29/11 Last day to notify election judges of duty to hold election (Writ of Election)
- 5/2/11** **First day to vote early in person: 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.**
- 5/6/11 Last day to receive an application for a ballot to be voted by mail.
- 5/10/11** **Last day to vote early by personal appearance; 5:00 p.m. deadline**
- ELECTION DAY**
- 5/14/11** 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. – Polls open at Auditorium.
7:00 p.m. – Deadline for receiving early voting ballots by mail.
- 5/17/11 – 5/25/11** **Board of Trustees to canvas election: specific date to be determined. (Post notice 72 hours before canvass.)**
- 5/19/11 Last day to receive carrier envelopes placed in the mail by 7:00 p.m. on election day, May 8, 2010, from voters who are voting outside the United States.
- 7/14/11 First day ballot box(es) may be unlocked and ballots transferred to secure container for remainder of preservation period.
- 3/15/13 Contents of ballot box(es) may be destroyed if no contest or criminal investigation has arisen.
