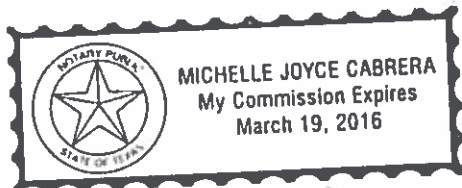

**PUBLIC NOTICE
ON PETITION REQUESTING
AN ELECTION
ON HOSPITAL CLOSING**

On September 16, 2014, the Nueces County Hospital District's (NCHD) Board of Managers (Board), under its authority at Texas Health and Safety Code, Chapter 285 (Health Code), ordered the closing of CHRISTUS Spohn Hospital Corpus Christi-Memorial (formerly Memorial Medical Center) located at 2506 Hospital Boulevard, Corpus Christi, Texas (Hospital). The Hospital is owned by NCHD and leased to and operated by CHRISTUS Spohn Health System Corporation. Under the Health Code, NCHD may be required to hold an election on the closing of the Hospital if, before the 31st day after the date the Board orders the closing, the Board receives a petition requesting the election signed by at least 10 percent of the qualified (registered) voters of the NCHD. NCHD's boundaries are coterminous with Nueces County.

Petitions are governed by the Texas Election Code, Chapter 277 (Election Code). Although NCHD does not support a petition effort, NCHD has prepared a sample petition form for public use on requesting an election on the issue of the closing of the Hospital should members of the public decide to pursue a petition effort. The NCHD sample petition form is available from NCHD without charge upon request or may be downloaded via the Internet from <http://www.nchdcc.org/pdf/Petition-Asking-for-NCHD-Election-on-Hospital-Closing.pdf>. Other petition forms may be used but must contain the Election Code-required information as contained in NCHD's sample petition; the signer's printed name, the signer's date of birth OR voter registration number, the signer's residence address, city, state, zip code, the signer's signature, and the date signed by the signer. In addition, the petition form must contain a statement at the top of the form stating the purpose of requesting an election, for example, "Requesting an election on the issue of the closing of CHRISTUS Spohn Hospital Corpus Christi-Memorial, formerly known as Memorial Medical Center."

A petition on requesting an election on the closing of the Hospital must be signed by at least 10 percent of the registered voters of Nueces County. The petition is due on or before Thursday, October 16, 2014 at 5:00 PM at NCHD's Administrative Offices located at Tower II, 555 N. Carancahua Street, Suite 950, Corpus Christi, Texas 78401-0835.

The NCHD Board is responsible for validating the petition's signatures pursuant to the Election Code and ordering an election, if appropriate. Once a petition has been filed with NCHD and NCHD has verified the signatures, NCHD's Board Secretary will present his certification of petition signature verification for the closing of the Hospital and, if appropriate, an election will be ordered at a publically-noticed NCHD Board meeting.
