- The Application Submission Window to perform or present a clinic/research presentation or participate in the JENerations Jazz Festival at the 5th Annual JEN Conference, January 8-11, 2014 in Dallas, TX will be from February 1st March 31st, 2013.
- · A TIMELINE has been established to communicate directly with you as detailed below.
- In the event you do not receive a SID Number from JEN within two weeks of your initial application, please DO contact us in that regard.
- Applications that do not COMPLY with JEN requirements will be discarded.
