Conditions of this Tech-Prep Articulation Agreement were formulated through meetings with representatives of the educational partners during which agreement was reached on student evaluation criteria, course content, and appropriate exit competencies. Under this agreement, the following conditions of articulation are hereby set forth.

#### 1. Credit in Escrow

1.1. Course(s) that can be held as “credit-in-escrow” under this agreement are listed on the individual agreements

Special Note: High school work transported to the college level is called “Credit-in-Escrow.” Approved semester credit hours will be awarded for high school work in Tech-Prep courses once the student has declared the major and met transfer requirements.

#### 2. Transfer

- 2.1. Upon entry to Odessa College (OC), the student must meet all of the OC admission requirements to be eligible for program continuation or credit via articulation.
- 2.2. The student must enroll at OC within 15 months of graduation, and MAY be required to take an OC challenge exam before “Credit-in-Escrow” is awarded.
- 2.3. Students must successfully complete, at least two non-developmental OC credit courses before “Credits-in-Escrow” will be applied to their OC transcript.
- 2.4. Students must have successfully completed each specified high school course with an end-of-course overall average of 80 or better in order for Credit-in-Escrow to be awarded.
- 2.5. The OC Admissions and Registrars Offices will be responsible for evaluating the official high school transcript and awarding articulated credit based on the conditions outlined in the Tech-Prep Articulation Agreement.
- 2.6. All Tech-Prep Articulation Agreements must be kept on file with the ISD, the appropriate OC Department, the Permian Basin Tech Prep Consortium, and the Odessa College Curriculum and Counselor’s offices.
- 2.7. Students will not be charged tuition or fees for Credits-in-Escrow earned under this agreement.
