Background Information:

- In October of 2013, a 6-person team of Aledo ISD staff attended the Multi-Hazard Emergency Operations Planning course at the Emergency Management Institute in Emmitsburg, MD
- In November of 2013, Aledo ISD completed a safety and security audit as required every three years by the Texas School Safety Center
- Both the EOP course and the audit revealed suggestions to plan for and exercise a potential relocation and reunification scenario
- All campus staff members participated in a relocation and reunification exercise on January 19, 2015
- Central office, transportation, and the Aledo ISD police department were also involved in the planning and execution of the exercise
- Six local churches were utilized as community partners for the completion of the exercise and further for planning of potential relocations in the future
