Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the sixth grading cycle (April 22, 2013 – June 6, 2013). Also, the overall attendance for the 2012-2013 school year is provided. Finally, there is attendance comparison for the weeks of state testing.

Objectives

- District-wide totals based on number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report
- Attendance figures are based on 32 instructional days (sixth cycle)
- Attendance for the school year is based on 177 instructional days

Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

Results

- The total attendance percentage for the Denton ISD for Cycle 6 is 96.21%.
- The lowest total attendance average is for 12th grade students at 93.77 % followed by 11th grade students at 95.41%
- The highest attendance averages are in the 5th and 3rd grades, 97.02%
- The district total for 2012-2013 is 95.99%
- Attendance averages appear to be higher during testing weeks
- 4/22/13 DISD enrollment 25,755; 6/06/13 enrollment 25,544 (-211)
