We are working on getting our applicants their CDL's. We are keeping in contact with them on a weekly basis to help them wherever possible. We just had a driver return after being on medical leave for the past month. We currently have one driver out on extended medical leave and will have another that goes into surgery on the 16th of November. Both will be out until after the first of January.

With these losses, we are having to use office staff and mechanics on occasion to cover routes. We always keep at least one mechanic in the shop at all times during morning and afternoon routes and will use other staff first. The mechanics are doing an amazing job in the shop and keeping up on our buses.

We have completed specs in order to work on getting our new buses for this year.

Due to lack of personnel, we will be unable to make any changes to routing this month.
