I. <u>SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT:</u> Supt. Glaes expressed condolences on behalf of the District to the family of former student Captain Drew Russell who was killed in Afghanistan.

A. Recognitions:

- National School Lunch Week: October 10-14 "Let's Grow Healthy": Director
 Maureen Ouvry stated that the Food Service Dept is focusing on healthy foods to
 help students learn.
- B. <u>Legislative Update:</u> Supt. Glaes referred to a science textbook which is part of the Battle Creek Math and Science Center Kits that is designed to support units in 7th grade science. The Farm Bureau expressed concerns about lack of objectivity in an article in *The Kalamazoo Gazette*. The District has not purchased the book and will not be doing so. Supt. Glaes also referred to a package of bills labeled "Parent Choice" which shifts funds away from public schools to charters and community colleges. The audience was encouraged to contact legislators.
- C. October 5, 2011 Count Figures: Supt. Glaes reported that while enrollment is down about 68 from the overall count from last year, Vicksburg is a strong recipient district from neighboring districts.

 - Asst. Supt. Goss reviewed the budget progress report for September 2011 showing total revenues of \$1,419,401; total expenditures of \$2,642,163; and deficiency of revenues over expenditures of -\$1,522,762.
- B. <u>Community Education Annual Report Tonya Nash:</u> Ms. Nash reported that 1400 students participated in dance; 290 students participated in Kids Klub; and B4K received 31 slots from the State last year for preschool.

the program, 22 improved, 5 maintained, 9 decreased, 4 were not tested, and 2 did not attend. Summer school teachers Marilyn Banner, Hollie Smith, Cara Brink, and Jill Treat were present.
