

Designation of Integrated Pest Management Coordinator

SUMMARY:

The Board will consider designating Billy Sprabeary as the Denton ISD Coordinator for Integrated Pest Management.

BOARD GOALS:

Be environmentally responsible and aggressively pursue energy efficiency and conservation principles in building design, transportation alternatives, and operating procedures.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

Bill Knight was previously approved as the Denton ISD coordinator for Integrated Pest Management on May 25, 2010.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The law requires that the Board of Trustees designate a district employee as the Coordinator for Pest Management Services.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

The District Integrated Pest Management Coordinator is required to attend training and certification sessions.
