Subject: 2025-2026 Student Code of Conduct

Background Information:

- 89th Legislative session adjusted a tremendous amount of policy and guidance that will be reflected in the 25-26 Student Code of Conduct.
- The Student Code of Conduct (SCOC) serves as the guiding document for Lewisville ISD related to all student discipline concerns.
- The SCOC must be approved by the Board of Trustees annually and becomes policy once adopted.
- We currently use the template model from TASB which provides compliance with Board legal policy, the Texas Education Code, and other applicable statutes. This model is then customized to reflect local policy and district administrative practices.
- The final document and proposed changes were reviewed by Jennifer Boniol, Director of Student Services, Leslie Davenport, Director of Student Services, Jeffrey Kajs, Chief Student Services Officer, and D'Ann Bey, LISD General Counsel.

Administrative Consideration:

- LISD Administration has also included a change document to provide an overall effort for each board member to see the changes and how it impacts LISD administration and students.
- Adoption prior to the start of school will allow availability to students, staff, parents, and community members.
- Posting of the SCOC is required by law and this document will be available on the district and campus websites in English and a format that allows translation into other languages.

Recommendations:

- LISD Administration recommends that the Board of trustees approve the document as provided with all the necessary changes for the 2025-2026 school year.

Timeline/Report:

- This Code of Conduct should be in place for the start of the 2025-2026 School year.
