

Bylaws of the Board

Attorney

The attorney of the Board of Education shall be the legal advisor of the Board and its officers in questions related to their official duties. The Board of Education ~~may~~ will appoint an attorney or attorneys to serve as school attorney. The primary function of the attorney is to provide professional legal counsel and representation for the Board and Superintendent.

The Board of Education requests the presence of the School Board Attorney to attend the first meeting in January after each election.

The attorney shall:

1. Represent the Board of Education in legal proceedings.
2. Give his/her written opinion on all legal questions referred to him/her by the Board of Education or the Superintendent.
3. Attend Board of Education meetings, conferences and other meetings as requested by the Board, Superintendent, Board Chairperson or Board committee.
4. Fulfill such other legal duties as the Board of Education may assign.
