Background:

April 17, 2012, the Board took action on Resolution 12-38 renewing the 2012-2013 employment contracts for contracted staff who are not required to hold a license issued by the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission and were employed during 2011-2012 as follows:

Since that approval the following contracs have been decreased or increased based on funding:

- Early Intervention/Early Childhood Special Education Occupational Therapist, has been increased from 190 days at .8 FTE to 190 days 1.0 FTE.
- Earily Intervention/Earlyy Childhood Special Education Specialist has been eliminated due to budget reductions. Through Bumping/RIFing rights, employee has agreed to accept the EI/ECSE Postive Behavior Specialist position at 190 days.

• Nurse Consultant position has been increased from 200 days to 210 days due to increased program needs.

WHEREAS, the Multnomah Education Service District Board authorizes the issuance of offers of reemployment for the next fiscal year, and

- WHEREAS, the Programs and Services Proposal (2012-2013) has been formulated based on the anticipated receipt of the funds necessary to support the programs in which the employees listed below will be assigned, and
- **WHEREAS,** in the event the anticipated resources are not received, each and every program is subject to reduction or elimination at the discretion of the Board.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director, Human Resource Services/Legal Counsel be authorized to issue employment contracts for the 2012-2013 fiscal year to the following individuals.
