

Board Report on Lone Star Governance Goal 3

The percentage of high school graduates considered College, Career or Military Ready will increase from 11% to 34% by May 2024.

Lone Star Governance Goal 3. Goal Progress Measure 3.1. Percentage of students meeting the ELAR proficiency standard on the Texas Student Initiative Assessment or successfully completing the college readiness course will increase from 15 to SY 19-20 22%, 20-21 26%.

ELAR TSI or College Readiness Course for 2018 Graduates meeting Goal Progress Measure 3.1: 24%

370 students met the criteria for CCMR out of 1,550

Lone Star Governance Goal 3. Goal Progress Measure 3.2. Percentage of students meeting the Math proficiency standard on the Texas Student Initiative Assessment or successfully completing the college readiness course will increase from 12% to SY 19-20 20%, 20-21 30%.

Math TSI or College Readiness Course of 2018 for 2018 Graduates meeting Goal Progress Measure 3.2: 14%

216 students met the criteria for CCMR out of 1,550

Lone Star Governance Goal 3. Goal Progress Measure 3.3. Percentage of students earning dual credit for at least 3 hours in ELA or Mathematics or 9 hours in any subject will increase from 24% to 30% by May 2022.

2018 Graduates meeting Goal Progress Measure 3.3 = 24%

368 students met the criteria for Dual Credit CCMR out of 1,550.
