## News from Mr. Regal

Welcome back from Thanksgiving Break,

Hopefully everyone had time over the break to spend with family and friends. We have just concluded our 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of school and had our first round of parent/teacher conferences on November 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>. **We sent progress reports home with students on November 27<sup>th</sup> for parents who were not available for conferences, so please check their backpacks.** If you were unable to come to conferences, please feel free to contact your child's teacher to discuss their progress in school.

The teachers and assistants have been working extremely hard in creating a safe learning environment for all children and provide your child with quality instruction in the classroom based on their individual needs. This year with 120 minutes of instruction designated to reading and 90 minutes of math at each grade level daily, students have been making academic gains based on the quality of instruction that our staff is providing all students. The **reading time** is broken up into 60 minutes of whole group, 30 minutes of small group, and 30 more minutes of intervention/enrichment for targeted instruction of individuals. The **math time** is broken up into 60 minutes of whole group and 30 minutes for intervention/enrichment. This has provided time for students to work on their own skill needs, while not missing any "CORE" instruction at their grade level.

The staff and students are working every day to show growth in their academic achievement levels in reading, math, and writing. Please continue to support your child academically at home by reading with your children or having them read 20 minutes a night at their **reading level** and practicing math facts (+/-/multiplication/division) nightly.

Do you like to explore or create? Become a scientist and participate in our 2018 Science Fair. If you qualify, or get approved, you will then participate in the District Science Fair, March 14th. This is a great opportunity to explore questions that you have always been wondering about, or to explore something new. We can't wait to see what you have discovered.

Public Law 105.17, known as the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), requires that school districts provide a free and appropriate education to all disabled children and young adults from birth through 21 years of age. ### **Why OverDrive?**

The OverDrive collection is an extension of your school's physical library; only it's online with 24/7 access to eBooks and audiobooks. It's convenient for students to check out titles at home, on the weekends or during school breaks with no worry about misplacing a book or running up late fees – these digital titles automatically return at the end of the lending period!

OverDrive can help students of all ages read more and improve comprehension. Struggling or reluctant readers, learning-challenged, second language learners, and gifted readers can all benefit from this service.

- Enrich vocabulary and improve comprehension and pronunciation
- Introduce students to books above their reading level
- Teach critical listening
- Help busy kids find time to read

### **How does it work?**

To use OverDrive, students browse our secure custom website, borrow with school computer username and password and enjoy anytime, anywhere on a computer, tablet, smartphone or eReader. Books may be downloaded to read offline.
