Claims;

- Our reimbursement for February is \$133,956.60. Last year's claim was for \$183,148.72. We served 14 days this year and 19 days last year.
- * We served 40,076 breakfasts in 2016 and 29,917 breakfasts in 2017. We averaged 2,109 in 2016 and 2,137 for 2017 so we are still showing a small increase for breakfast.
- * We served 36,337 lunches in 2017 and 46,334 for 2016. The daily average for 2017 is 2596 and for 2016 2439 servings. We are showing an increase of 157 serving for February of 2017.

Projects;

- * The maintenance ground crew is almost done with demolition of the inside of our warehouse on the east side. We are now in the process of getting bids for the new freezer box. We still need to have the walls cut where the overhead doors are going and also the wall between the existing warehouse and the new side of the warehouse needs to come down if the structure engineer says that we can take it down.
- * We are still trying to get the remodeling scheduled at Minico so that we can increase the size of our freezer and cooler boxes.
