Basic information:

Aramark Corporation is our current food service provider as a result of last year's food procurement process. They have submitted their proposal for contract renewal for the school year 2025-2026. This 1-year renewal is the 2nd year of the allowable 5-year renewals (1 year at a time) for any food service provider. The contract calls for an increase of 3.6% over the contract for the 2024-25 school year. This is in line with the CPI (Consumer Price Index) Food Away From Home (Dec. 2024) food cost increase nationally. This percentage is calculated by the U.S. Dept of Labor (see attached).

Because of D33's high level of Low-Income students, we are able to offer every student in D33 a free breakfast and lunch every school day through the CEP program. The State (they administer this Federal program) then reimburses the district approximately 99% of the cost to serve our students. The total cost to serve our students in a normal school year is approximately \$1.9 million per year.
