Softball and Tennis are already being offered in the Middles Schools as UIL sanctioned programs.

Baseball Pilot Program Details

Implementation of Pilot Program

- Develop one team comprised of 7th and 8th graders to compete in a UIL 8th grade division.
- Competition schedule will need to run in the fall in order to utilize the high school baseball fields for practice and competitions.
- Parents will need to transport their child to high schools for practice sessions.
- BISD will transport teams for competitions.
- Proposed Middle School athletic plans and schedule will need to be approved by the Middle UIL committee, which is comprised of ten middle school principals.
- Proposed schedule: October 28th- December 18th

Personnel

- One P.E.-Athletics- FTE- teacher position for athletic/physical education classes
- Hire two stipend- coaches per campus- Cost estimate: \$ 44,000.00

Transportation costs

- Transport to games and 2 practices each week to high school fields
- Cost estimate \$20,000.00

Meal costs

- \$ 5,000.00

Supply Costs

- \$4,500.00 per school = \$45,000

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
