Abbott signed HB 3372 into law, and it became effective immediately. HB 3372 revises Texas Education Code Section 11.006 to prohibit school administrators from contracting for personal services with 1) any business entity that conducts or solicits business with the school district that employs the administrator, 2) an educational entity that does business with any district in the state for curricular or administrative services, or 3) another school district, charter school, or educational service center unless the Board of Trustees for the district employing the administrator approves the contract and officially determines the contract 1) does not harm Frisco ISD, 2) does not create a conflict of interest, and 3) the services will be performed on the administrator's personal time.
