Subject: Middle School Math Instructional Materials

Background Information:

- The current LISD-adopted Middle School math resources are Savvas Learning (2015).
- During the 88th Texas Legislative Session, House Bill 1605 initiated a process for the SBOE to review and approve high-quality instructional materials (HQIM). Additional funding was created for HQIM. The IMRA (Instructional Materials Review and Approval) process outlines the steps for reviewing instructional materials, with the SBOE having final authority over the system, criteria used, and approvals.
- HB 1605 created 2 new entitlement funds:
 - SBOE Approved Instructional Material Entitlement funds (Bucket 2).
 - \$40 additional dollars per student are available to use for the purchase of HQIM materials.
 - Note: This is an annual amount we receive in Bucket 2, per student, not per subject. Remaining balance in this bucket does roll over year to year.
 - State-Developed Open Education Resources Entitlement (OER) funds (Bucket 3)
 - \$20 additional dollars per student are available to use for the purchase of OER materials from the TEA approved list for printing purposes.
 - Note: This is an annual amount we receive in Bucket 3, per student, not per subject, for printing purposes only. The remaining balance does not roll over year to year and the deadline for this bucket is August 31 annually.
- The SBOE instructional materials review process analyzed materials submitted by vendors based on their alignment to the TEKS and will release updated approved HQIM materials annually according to a TEA schedule with Math options being released in November 2025.
- LISD will go through the process of adopting a Math HQIM in SY25-26 for implementation in SY26-27 for all schools. This process includes teachers and stakeholders and provides opportunities for interaction with the products for teachers as well as parent feedback and preview sessions as a part of the considerations for decision making.

- Approve the purchase of SBOE approved TEA Open Education Resource (OER) Bluebonnet Learning Grades 6-8 Secondary Mathematics for the following campuses at a cost of:

 - DeLay Middle School
 - Durham Middle School

 - Lakeview Middle School
 - Griffin Middle School
