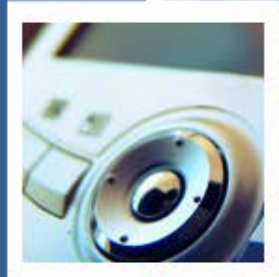

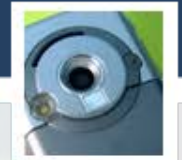


Portable Devices

Staffing Changes

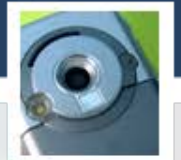


- Instructional Innovation Facilitator

Estimated Costs 2015-2016



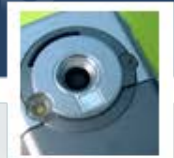

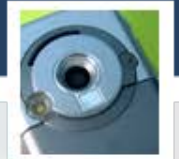

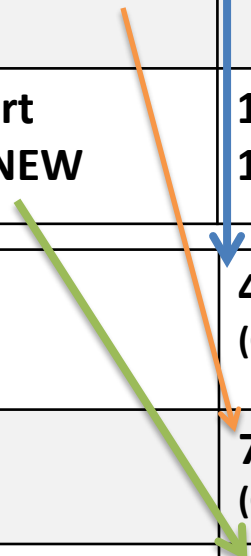
