AMS/ McAnally Shared Space: Need

- Aledo Middle School enrollment for 2019-2020 is currently 1,006 students
- Projected enrollment for Aledo Middle School for 2020-2021 is 1,170 students
- Enrollment next year is 16% greater at AMS compared to this year
- AMS is anticipated to be approximately 105% of maximum capacity next year
- McAnally Intermediate, as a one-grade campus, has a projected enrollment of 545 next year, or approximately 61% of max capacity
- AMS needs space; McAnally has space; the two campuses are roughly ½ mile apart



AMS/ McAnally Shared Space: Plan

- District has designed a plan to minimize the impact on core content classes, the movement of students between schools during the day, and the disruption to the regular schedule at McAnally
- This plan reduces the number of students at AMS during heaviest class periods of the day and one lunch section
- Some students will travel to McAnally for two electives classes during 3rd period and 4th period and will then eat lunch at McAnally before returning to AMS
- AMS students will take all core content at AMS campus, and will travel to McAnally at the end of CAT time following 2nd period
- AMS students will travel back after lunch and be present for the start of 5th period at AMS
- This plan may need to be revised in the spring due to construction impact on the building.
