*Science:* Complete Grades 3, 4 and 6 Summer 2018 Initiate Grade 5: June 2018, Complete June 2019 Initiate and complete Grades K, 1 and 2 in 2019/20

Social Studies: Grade 5 and 6 Initiate Summer 2018 Grades K-4 in 2019/20

## Curriculum Revision Cycle:

2019/20 Social Studies K-4, Science K-2 2020/21 Fine & Practical Arts Review (also includes PE/Health, Technology, Library/Media, Music & World Language) 2021/22 Language Arts Review 2022/23 Math Review 2023/24 Science Review

Discussion ensued regarding the timeline for Math curriculum completion. It was suggested that communication with parents occur regarding the timeline process as well as anticipated completion of the current curriculum. The committee also discussed integration of Social studies into other curriculum areas. A recommendation was made to spread out the Fine and Practical Arts review and will be considered.

Superintendent Gilbert provided an overview of the June 6 Superintendent's Parents Academy on Transition to a School-Wide Enrichment Model.

The committee asked that the principal include a "curriculum topic highlight" as part of the BRS update to the Board at their monthly meeting beginning with the 2018/19 school year. Other areas that may be explored for inclusion of this information could encompass the *Woodbridge Town News* and possibly Instagram.
