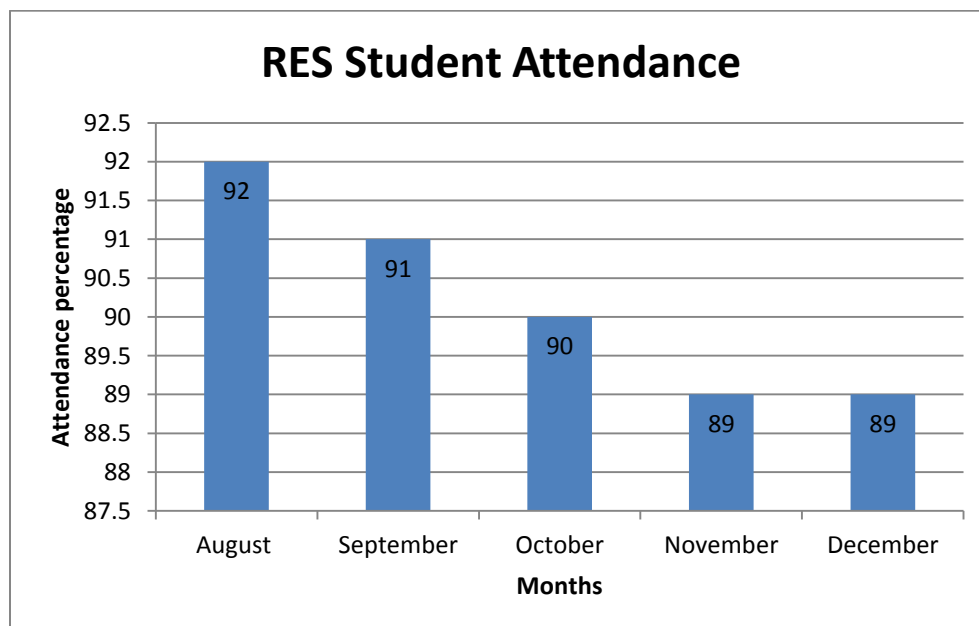


Student Attendance

In December 2012, there were a total of 14 days of school. The overall percentage rate for all students enrolled in Kindergarten through 6th grade was 88%. 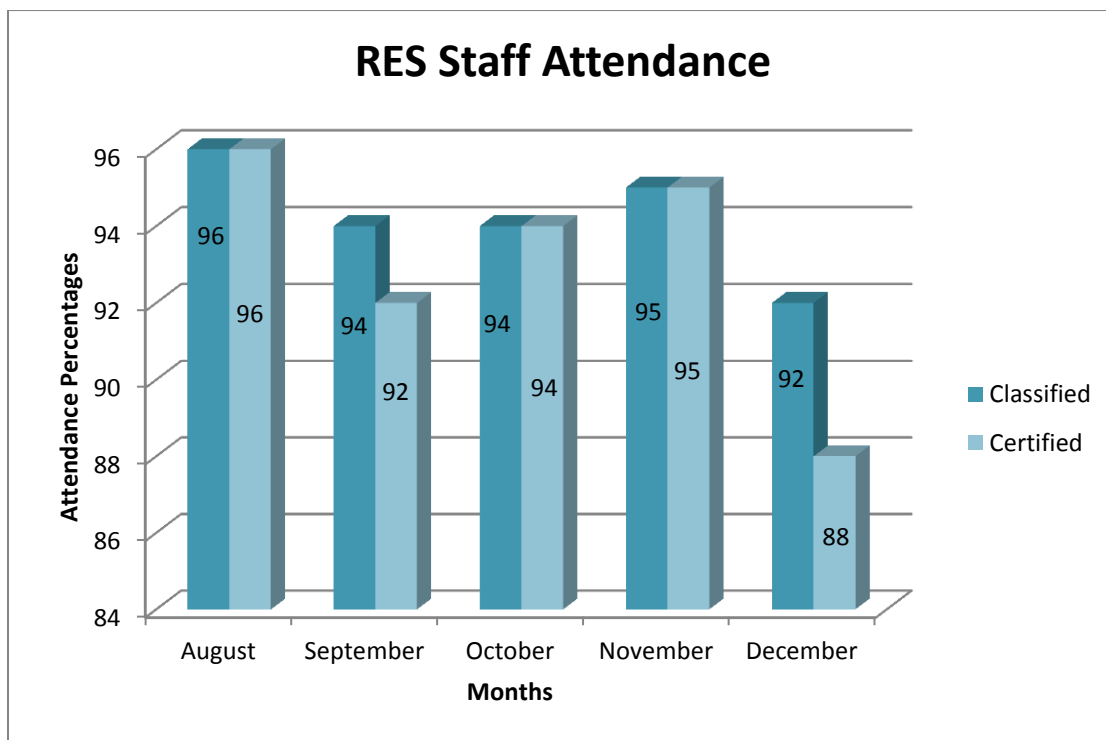

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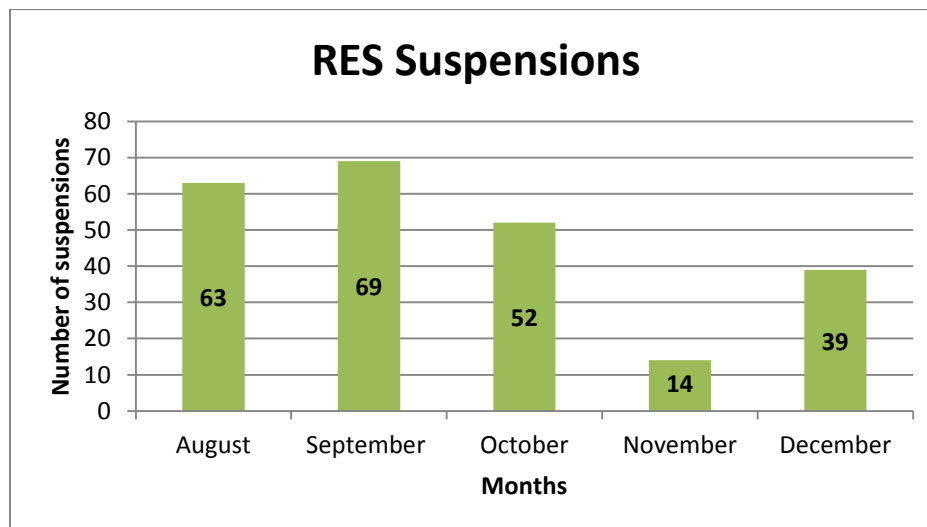
