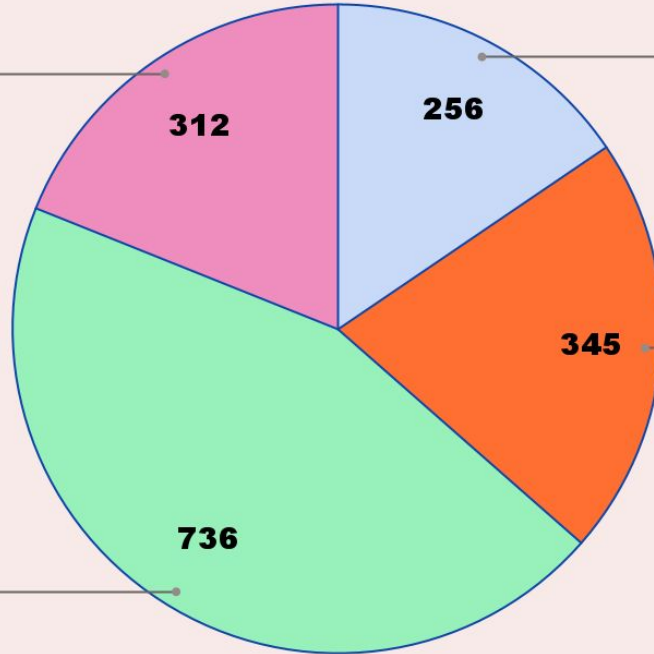

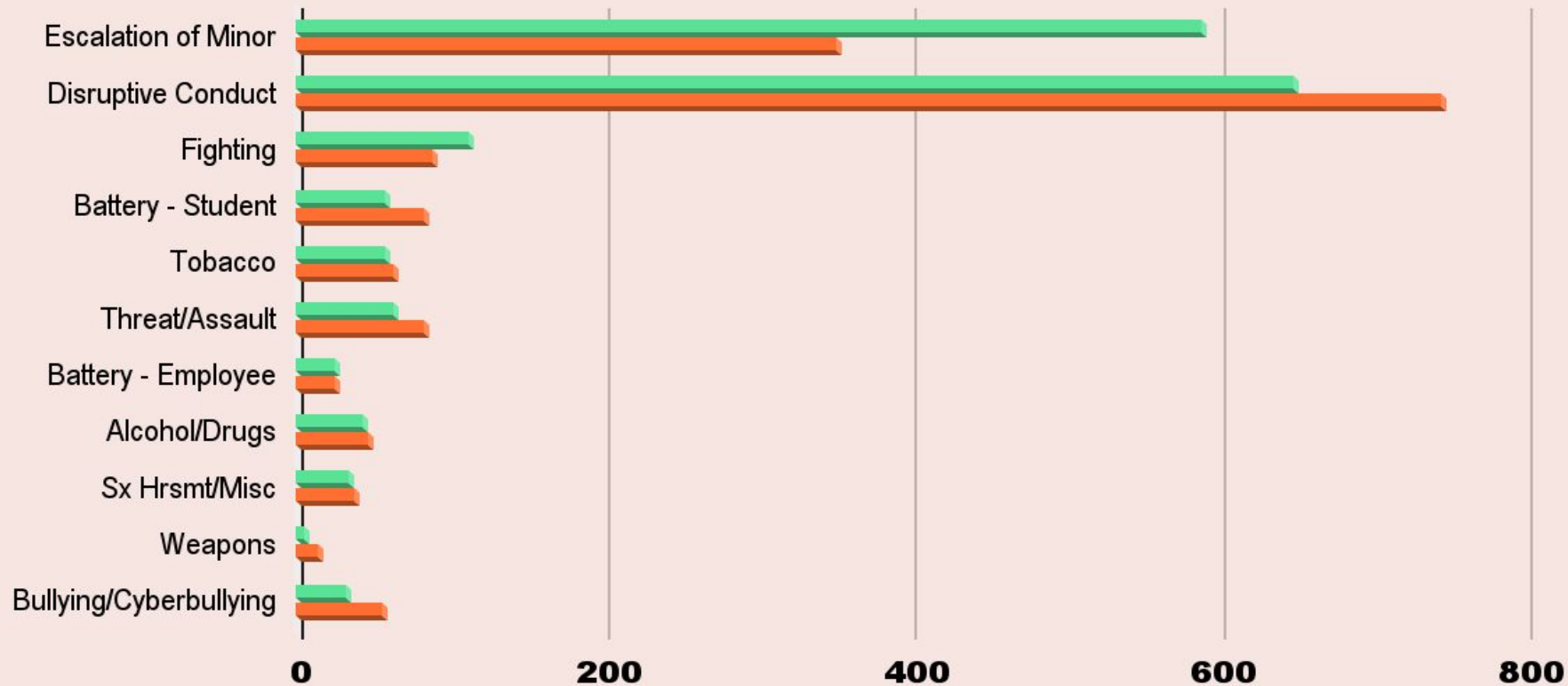

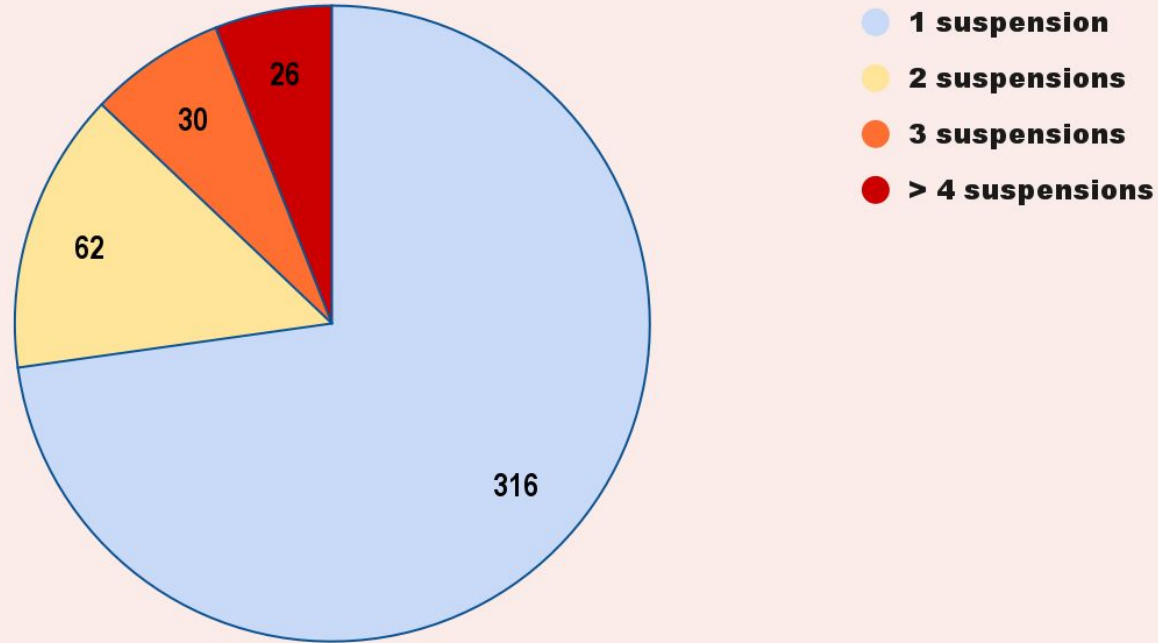
Behavior Events by Type

Summary

- There is a slight decrease in student behavior events
- Middle schools continue to have more behavior events than other school levels
- Incidents on the school bus have continued to decrease
- Of 1652 behavior events
 - 434 resulted in suspension (26%)
 - All others resulted in parent contact, detention, or alternative consequences
- Of 5694 students in grades PK - 12:
 - 7.5% with one suspension
 - 2% with two or more suspensions
