

**#1380 Regulation
Sexual Offenders on School Property**

5 Pursuant to state law, the Connecticut Department of Emergency Services and Public
6 Protection is obligated to notify school superintendents whenever a sexual offender is
7 released into the community or whenever a registered sexual offender changes his or her
8 address.

9
10 School district personnel shall cross-reference the Connecticut Department of Emergency
11 Services and Public Protection’s sexual offender registry prior to hiring any new
12 employee and prior to permitting a volunteer to work with students in any capacity.
13 Registration as a sexual offender constitutes grounds for denial of employment and/or
14 volunteer opportunities in the Madison Public Schools.

15
16 The Superintendent or his/her designee shall provide training to appropriate staff
17 members regarding the methods for accessing the sexual offender registry information
18 posted on the Connecticut Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection and
19 the provisions of these regulations.
