## ITINERARY

**Day 1** **Depart USA**  
 Depart MSP overnight to Europe on scheduled air service. Fly transatlantic overnight with complimentary meals, beverages, and inflight entertainment. Meals: Inflight

**Day 2** **Munich | Salzburg**  
 Morning arrival in Europe where you connect to your onward flight to Munich. On arrival, meet your professional Austrian tour managers and travel by deluxe motor coach to Salzburg, birth city of W.A. Mozart and film location for "The Sound of Music." A lunch stop will be made en route. Get settled into your hotel. Welcome dinner at the hotel. Inflight/D

**Day 3** **Salzburg**  
 Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy "Sound of Music" Salzburg today. Take a morning guided walk through the Old Town to see the Mirabell Gardens, Salzburg Dom and Mozart's birth-house. Conclude the tour with a trip up the funicular to the Hohensalzburg Fortress which towers over the city. Marvel at the stunning historical beauty of this city with a walk down the Getreidegasse. Afternoon free to explore Salzburg. Have dinner together and then perform an evening concert with a local Austrian band (TBC). B/D

**Day 4** **Salzkammergut | Salzburg**  
 Spend the day in the beautiful Salzkammergut lake region of Austria. Depart for Bad Dürnborg where you tour an Austrian Salt Mine, which has been actively working since the Middle Ages. Later, see the Parish Church of St. Michel in Mondsee. This was the wedding site used in the "Sound of Music" film. Return to Salzburg with the evening free for dinner with friends in the Old Town. B

**Day 5** **Salzburg | Innsbruck**  
 Depart from Salzburg on a scenic drive to Olympic Innsbruck. Travel through an enchanting landscape of beautiful mountains and rivers. Make a stop at Berchtesgaden, Germany for lunch. Arrive in Innsbruck, a city surrounded by the Alps where we do a brief panoramic tour of some of Innsbruck's highlights. Check-in at the hotel. Enjoy dinner and the Tirolean Abend Folklore show with local traditional music and dance. B/D

**Day 6** **Schwangau | Innsbruck**  
 Depart from Innsbruck and cross the Alps over the Fern Pass to Schwangau, Germany. Enjoy a panoramic hike with your tour managers featuring breathtaking views of Neuschwanstein Castle. Take photos and return to the village for lunch. Continue to the town of Ehrenberg where you will visit the Ehrenberg Castle with imposing views of the valleys below. Return to Innsbruck later in the evening. B

**Day 7** **Innsbruck**  
 Begin the day with a performance at a local school followed by a social exchange with the students. After time for lunch, enjoy a guided walking tour of the medieval Old Town of Innsbruck. See the Golden Roof, the Arch of Maria Theresa and the ornately colored Baroque houses along the River Inn. The remainder of the afternoon is free for exploring in small groups and doing some souvenir shopping. If weather permits, you may wish to take the Nordkettenbahn cable-car up into the Alps to Seegrube. Dinner at the hotel tonight. B/D

**Day 8** **Innsbruck | Dachau | Munich**  
 Depart from Innsbruck back into Germany towards Munich. Arrive at the former Nazi Concentration Camp at Dachau where you visit the Holocaust Museum. Enjoy sightseeing in Munich and see the new Town Hall on the charming Marienplatz. After free time for shopping in Munich, check into your hotel and enjoy a traditional German farewell dinner. B/D

**Day 9** **Return to USA**  
 Return to MSP from Munich on scheduled air service. Arrive in the Twin Cities in the late afternoon or evening. Clear U.S. Immigration and Customs at MSP. Welcome home! B/Inflight

## TOUR FINANCE

### PAYMENT SCHEDULE (SAMPLE)

### CANCELLATION POLICY

- 120 or more days prior to departure = Full refund
- 119 to 90 days prior = \$500 cancellation fee (tour deposit)
- 89 to 60 days prior = \$1,000 cancellation fee
- 59 to 30 days prior = \$1,500 cancellation fee
- 29 to 0 days prior = No refund (100% penalty)
