**DISCUSSION:** Implementation of Workday Finance, Human Capital

Management, and Payroll is planned to begin in spring and is anticipated to take approximately 14-18 months. The cost for five years of Worldow subscriptions as well as the

for five years of Workday subscriptions as well as the combined implementation costs with contingency is not to

exceed \$11,500,000.

Sierra Cedar is the primary implementation partner for Workday. They are providing the subject matter experts for Finance, Human Capital Management, Payroll, and technical support for security and system integrations.

PTG (Precision Task Group) will provide overall project management, data conversion, and state reporting

assistance.

Budget funding for fiscal year 2019-20 for this project will come from the College's Innovation Fund. \$2.5M of this fund will be allocated to the Workday project for the remainder of this fiscal year. Future expenses associated

with Workday will be budgeted separately.

DISTRICT PRESIDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:
