to:

**Based upon authorization of the Board, the** committee may take on additional activities, including the creation of subcommittees.

The revised draft of the charge for the C.C.C. is being presented to the Board this evening for discussion. In addition, Board member Jennifer Reddy and Communications Coordinator Chris Jасulca are seeking input from the Board regarding the next steps in determining whether the C.C.C. will become a standing committee of the District 97 Board of Education.
