Recommendation:

The administration recommends the board consider and approve the Adjunct Faculty Agreement with Bexar and Kendall Counties.

Summary:

Students who participate in activities with Bexar and Kendall Counties during the school day are considered on a school trip and not counted absent when we have this agreement in place. This saves the district ADA funding for the student and allows the student to make up lost work without penalty.

Rationale:

A student not actually on campus when attendance is taken may be considered in attendance for FSP purposes if the student is participating in a board-approved activity under the direction of a member of a district's professional or paraprofessional staff, or an adjunct staff member who has a bachelor's degree and is eligible for participation in TRS. 19 TAC 129.21(i)–(k)
