



Local Policy Revisions

- Revisions are recommended to 3 local policies.
- Revisions were prepared in coordination with TASB Policy Service and ECISD legal counsel.

CH (LOCAL)

PURCHASING AND ACQUISITION

- Update 126 brought a change to CV (Local) to reflect the new state threshold at which competitive procurement is required for individual purchases: \$50,000 to \$100,000.
- This revision aligns the purchasing approval limit delegated to the Superintendent with the prior change from \$50,000 to \$100,000 for single, budgeted purchases.
- Purchases at or above \$100,000 will continue to require Board approval unless otherwise specified.
- Revision will be implemented immediately.

Purchasing Authority

The Board delegates to the Superintendent the authority to make budgeted purchases for goods or services. However, any single, budgeted purchase of goods or services that costs ~~\$50,000~~ \$100,000 or more, except as provided below, shall require Board approval before a transaction may take place.

ACCOUNTING INVENTORIES

- The capitalization threshold for individual capital assets has changed at the federal level to reflect \$10,000, and the state of Texas is finalizing a similar change to \$10,000.
- This proposed revision increases the capitalization threshold for ECISD from \$5,000 to \$10,000 to keep us in alignment with both the state and federal guidelines.
- Revision will be implemented immediately.

Capitalization Threshold	The capitalization threshold for purposes of classifying individual capital assets shall be \$5,000 \$10,000. The Superintendent shall determine the capitalization threshold for a group of assets, the individual cost of which does not exceed the capitalization threshold above but for which the cost in the aggregate is significant.
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EHBE (LOCAL)

SPECIAL PROGRAMS: BILINGUAL EDUCATION/ESL

- EHBE (Legal) already contains the required parameters related to education for emergent bilingual students. When ECISD moved to dual language instruction district-wide, we were required to add policy language to EHBE (Local) that outlined the details of this instructional program.
- With the current proposed change in programming, the dual language instruction text will no longer be necessary. Therefore, you see the deletion of text in EHBE (Local) red-line.
- Language specific to the Transitional Bilingual Model Program will be included in administrative regulations.
- Program changes will take effect with the 2026–2027 school year.
